All Brains Belong's Community Health & Access Fund: A Patient-Led Model of Mutual Aid in Action

In the absence of accessible systems, patients are creating their own.

The Community Health & Access Fund began as a grassroots initiative by neurodivergent patients at All Brains Belong — people with complex chronic health needs, most of whom rely on Medicaid and other government services. When the system didn't meet their needs, they stepped up to support each other.

What the Fund Supports

- Over-the-counter medications and supplements that patients cannot afford due to cost
- Grocery cards to ensure safe nutrition
 Subsidized sliding scale access to neuroinclusive healthcare for patients without insurance

Why This Matters

- Most ABB patients are medically complex, disabled, and low-income.
- Many were skipping meds or care due to cost.
- Patients began organizing to meet their own needs and it's working. We've already kept 10 people out of the Emergency Room in the last 6 weeks. This Fund will provide medicines, groceries, supplies, and healthcare appointments for 50 more patients this year.

Why Now

- Economic instability is rising.
- Many of ABB's community partners are losing funding some may not exist by fall.
- This Fund is an opportunity to invest in a scalable, patient-led, public health strategy.
